
## **GENERAL SIGN INSTALLATION**

These instructions are intended for installation on concrete, brick or drywall surfaces. Always consult your internal maintenance department to discuss the specifics of your project.



- 1. Find someone to assist with installation. Do not attempt to install yourself.
- 2. Measure the space you have designated for the sign and determine where it should be placed.
- 3. Place the sign against the wall and check to make sure it is level. Mark the sign in pencil where you would like to place screws.
- 4. Pre-drill the sign in the marked locations using a ¼" wood drill bit. Use the sign as a template to mark the wall with a pencil through the pre-drilled holes.
- 5. Using a drill bit appropriate for your wall surface, drill ¼" holes at the marked locations. Install multi-surface, plastic wall anchors¹ using a rubber mallet.

- 6. Install the sign with the provided screws<sup>2</sup>, making sure the plastic screw cap<sup>3</sup> is attached.
- 7. Complete the installation by snapping the screw caps<sup>3</sup> closed over the screw head.
