
## **VELCRO-PANEL RECORD BOARD INSTALLATION**

These instructions are intended for installation on concrete, brick or drywall surfaces. Always consult your internal maintenance department to discuss the specifics of your project.



- 1. Find at least two people to assist with installation. Do not attempt to install yourself.
- 2. Measure the space you have designated for the record board and determine where the center panel should be placed.
- 3. Place the center panel of the record board on the wall to verify desired placement.
- Check the panel to make sure it's level and mark the board in pencil where you would like to place screws. (When installing on a brick or block wall, it is often easier to drill into the mortared joints rather than into the brick/ block itself)
- 5. Pre-drill the panel in these marked locations using a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" wood drill bit. Once pre-drilled, place the panel back on the wall in the desired location. Using the board as a template, mark the location of the holes with a pencil.

- Using a drill bit appropriate to your wall surface, drill <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" holes at the marked locations. Install multi-surface, plastic wall anchors<sup>1</sup> using a rubber mallet.
- 7. Install the panel with provided screws<sup>2</sup>, making sure the plastic screw cap<sup>3</sup> is attached. Once secure, finish by snapping the cap down over the screw head.
- 8. Working from the center panel out, align each panel seaming the background together. Repeat steps 4 7 for each background panel.
- 9. Once the background panels are in place, attach the Velcro record panels aligning with the markers printed on the background of the board.
